

Child Neurology of Tulsa Pharmacy Policy

Please be aware that Child Neurology of Tulsa provides prescriptions during visits with adequate refills to provide enough medication until the next scheduled visit. If a visit is missed or rescheduled then Child Neurology of Tulsa requires the patient (parent/guardian) to call for refill requests and additional medication will be prescribed until the next visit.

All Pharmacy generated fax medication refills are discarded as these are automated and do not indicate need for a prescription from Dr. Siegler.

Prescriptions written during office visits will be provided as requested for either 1 month supply (standard) or 3 month supply (typical for mail-order pharmacies). Please be aware that the patient/parent/guardian is responsible for faxing prescriptions for mail-order pharmacies.

Between office visit prescriptions may be subject to a fee depending on the clinical circumstances (ie. missed visits). If doses are increased between visits, there is no charge for call in prescriptions.

Any requested change from brand to generic medications requires an office visit so that Dr. Siegler may review the complex issues involved so that you may make an informed decision.
